	Use a manual defrost freezer and avoid repeated freeze thaw cycles. Store at 2 to 8°C for
	frequent use. Store at -20 to -80°C for twelve months from the date of receipt.
Background:	High density lipoproteins (HDLs) play a critical role in cholesterol metabolism and their
	plasma concentrations are inversely correlated with risk for atherosclerosis. The SR-BI
	(Scavenger Receptor BI) protein binds HDLs and mediates selective uptake of HDL
	cholesteryl ester. SR-BI binds HDL with high affinity, is expressed primarily in liver and
	nonplacental steroidgenic tissues, and mediates selective cholesterol uptake by a distinct
	mechanism. In mice, it seems that SR-BI plays a key role in determining the levels of plasma
	lipoprotein cholesterol and the accumulation of cholesterol stores in the adrenal gland.
	Scavenging Receptor SR-BI plays a critical role in HCV attachment and/or cell entry by
	interacting with HCV E1/E2 glycoproteins heterodimer.
