	brain, spleen, small intestine, kidney, testis, placenta, breast, colon, ganglion, heart, and
	aortic smooth muscle. The Y2 receptor is found mainly in the central nervous system. NPY
	receptors are a member of the G protein-coupled receptor superfamily.
